



1. Out of Bounds.

Out of Bounds is indicated by white stakes and is defined by a straight line between

The access road along the left of the 6th hole is out of bounds, as is the wall of the Gatehouse and its extension closer to the green, and a ball coming to rest against it on the inside of the course may only be moved within 2 club-lengths, not nearer the hole and under penalty of 1 stroke under the Unplayable Ball rule (Rule28). The clubhouse and parking lot are out of bounds.

2. Water Hazards: Yellows stakes.

Keep the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard between you and the hole (Rule26-1).

Lateral Water Hazards: Red Stakes.

Drop a ball within 2 club-lengths of the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard and NOT nearer the hole.

3. All Drop Zones.

All Drop Zones are optional, otherwise proceed under Point 2 above as for water

4. Young Trees.

Relief must be taken from staked young trees and their irrigation bowls. All other irrigation bowls are in play.

5. Ground Under Repair.

Relief may be taken from areas ringed with white paint.

6. Lightning Procedure.

1 long blast = play suspended; stop immediately.

2 blasts repeated = resume play.

Golfers who do not heed the sirens will lose their place in the field when the course re-
