Houghton Golf Club - Dress Code

At Houghton Golf Club, our dress standards are a reflection of the Club's distinguished heritage, contemporary elegance, and commitment to excellence. We ask all members, guests, and visitors to maintain a standard of dress that upholds the Club's reputation as one of South Africa's premier golf destinations.

General Expectations

- Attire must always be neat, presentable, and in good taste.
- Smart casual is the minimum standard throughout the Club's facilities.
- Golf attire should align with the standards seen on the PGA, LPGA, and DP World Tours.
- Club staff are authorised to courteously address any dress that falls short of these expectations.

Clubhouse (Members' Lounge, Restaurant, Conference Facilities)

Permitted:

- Tailored jeans (free from rips, frays, or distressing)
- Golf wear and smart casual clothing
- Collared shirts or fashionable golf tops
- Smart sneakers, loafers, or dress shoes
- Neat activewear is permitted

Not Permitted:

- Sloppy or overly casual gym wear is not acceptable
- Beachwear, or excessively casual footwear

Permitted:

- Collared shirts, golf-specific tops, golf dresses
- Tailored shorts, trousers, skirts, and skorts
- Golf shoes or suitable soft-soled sports shoes

Not Permitted:

- Denim of any kind, cargo or board shorts
- T-shirts without collars
- Caps or visors worn backwards

Driving Range and 10th Putting Green

- Relaxed, golf-appropriate attire is acceptable
- Neat activewear is permitted for practice sessions
- Golf shoes, sneakers, or trainers are recommended
- Swimwear, torn clothing, or garments with inappropriate messaging are not permitted

Padel Courts & Kids' Play Area

- Activewear and sportswear appropriate for physical activity is welcome
- Court-specific shoes are required on the Padel courts
- While relaxed, attire should still be clean and respectful in shared Club spaces

Additional Guidelines

- Children aged 12 and over are expected to adhere to the adult dress code.
- Changing of clothes must be done in locker rooms or designated changing areas only.
- Members are responsible for ensuring their guests are familiar with and comply with the Club's dress expectations.
